COVID-19 Vaccinations for Children Age 5 or Older Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

Do children really need to get vaccinated against COVID-19?

COVID-19 isn't just infecting healthy young people; it is causing serious illness and death. Children can spread COVID-19 to others including vulnerable members of their family and community. Everyone age 5 and older should get vaccinated as soon as possible.

How do I know the vaccine is safe and effective?

We urge you to get the facts about vaccine safety and efficacy. As your health care provider, know that we trust the rigorous science behind these vaccines. Do not believe rumors and conspiracy theories.

Do I have to be a patient to schedule a vaccine appointment?

No. You do not need to be a patient. We offer COVID-19 vaccination to all eligible adults, regardless of patient status, immigration status, insurance status, or ability to pay.

Is it safe for me to get a COVID-19 vaccine if I would like to have a baby one day?

Yes. COVID-19 vaccination is recommended for everyone 5 years and older, including people who are trying to get pregnant now or might become pregnant in the future, as well as their partners. Currently no evidence shows that any vaccines, including COVID-19 vaccines, cause fertility problems (problems trying to get pregnant) in women or men.
